# **Primary Responsibilities:**

# Canoe trip related:

- 1) Pre-trip: Prepare bins for all meals for groups on orientation day, assist cook with meal prep and clean up as needed. Prep and prepare breakfast the morning trips leave.
- 2) Food packing: Prepare all mixes or foods used for trips. Prep and clean up work stations. Work with each group as they pack food. Alert head cook when items need reordering.
- 3) Post-trip: Prepare items for lunch. Bring leadership to group clean up in the kitchen.
- 4) Assist with supper as needed.

# Kitchen responsibilities:

- 1) Assist Head cook with meals or dishes as needed.
- 2) Care for overall kitchen cleanliness and clutter control following kitchen expectations.
- 3) If interested and skilled, bake bread for Lakeside guests.
- 4) Empty compost, recycling and garbage as needed.
- 5) Other miscellaneous tasks as needed.

This job description can be combined with other jobs including the gardener, maintenance assistant or other positions.

#### Position starts in late May and goes until mid to late August (dates are flexible).
