- 7) Enjoyment in working with others
- 8) Good communication skills

## Responsibilities include:

- Oversee all projects related to buildings and grounds including upkeep, repair, and new construction/development
- Supervise and direct maintenance assistants as needed
- Responsible for setting up and taking down camp
- Responsible for maintenance and upkeep of all vehicles
- Providing transportation to and from entry points for groups
- Maintain, repair, and replace camping equipment or send for repairs as needed
- Maintain trails and beach area
- Miscellaneous tasks as needed for services to campers and smooth operations.
- Option (if interested) to join a maximum of two canoe trips in the course of the summer.
