Tent Site Guidelines

- Please **pitch your tent** in one of the four numbered sites in the forest.
- **The Bath House and Gathering Place** (round wooden building) are at your disposal.
- **Trash, Compost, and Recycling** can be disposed of in the appropriate containers outside the Bath House.
- **Water is available** outside the bathhouse: hot and cold spigots on the side facing the lake, filtered water on the forest-side. Water from all three spigots as well as tap water is safe to drink. *Please, no washing of dishes in the bathhouse sinks. Wash basins, if you need them, can be found in the Gathering Place.*
- **Fishing boats, canoes, and kayaks** on the lake-shore are available for all Wilderness Wind guests to use on Armstrong Lake. If you would like to take a day trip in the Boundary Waters or elsewhere, please contact Wilderness Wind staff for canoe/kayak rental options.
- **Keep fires small** and within fire-ring. Douse until cold.
- Please be respectful of other guests who have come to experience the tranquility of the wilderness. **Quiet hours are 9:30 p.m. to 8:30 a.m.**
- **Smoking and firearms** prohibited. **Open containers or alcohol prohibited** in public spaces.
- **Please tidy up** the site when you leave, making sure all trash and personal belongings are packed out.

Wilderness Wind's office is located at Pine Ridge, our base camp property. Drive west on Hwy 169 (towards Ely) for 4 miles; it will be on your left. A large timber-framed sign marks the driveway.
